Properties/uses: trouble sleeping, cardiovascular diseases, stress relief Conditions: dry, well-drained, sandy or coarse dirt in full sunlight Size: 3 feet high, 1-3 feet wide Fragrance: delicate, sweet smell that is floral, herbal & woodsy at the same time



Properties/uses: highly toxic, asthma, epilepsy, headaches & atrial fibrillation Conditions: shaded woodland, nearby hedges, well-drained, moist soil Size: 3 feet high, 2 inches wide Fragrance: petrichor (freshly rained-

#### on grass)

# ST. JOHN'S WORT



Properties/uses: depression, ADHD, insomnia, OCD, PMS Conditions: moist and well-drained soil in full to partial sunlight Size: 2-4 inches high, 1.5-2 feet wide Fragrance: akin to lavender with sweet and spicy tones

ROSEMARY



Properties: antibacterial, antiviral, antifungal, mood lifting Conditions: full sun with welldraining soil Size: 4 feet high, 4 feet wide Fragrance: pungent and astringent scent similar to eucalyptus





Properties/uses: depression, anxiety, brain health, gastrointestinal problems Conditions: virtually any soil conditions, best for dry soil Size: 3 feet high, 3-5 inches wide Fragrance: sweet and herby



Properties/uses: menopausal symptoms, memory and brain health Conditions: warm and sunny, sheltered areas

Size: 12-24 inches high, 30 inches wide Fragrance: earthy aroma with a herbaceous scent




Properties/uses: bacterial and fungal infections, dementia, mood lifting Conditions: sunny areas with moist soil Size: 6-12 inches high, 12 inches wide Fragrance: strong and intensely fresh, very herbaceous

### CHAMOMILE



Properties/uses: digestive relaxant, trouble sleeping, motion sickness and nausea Conditions: well-drained soil in full or partial shade Size: 11-23 inches high, 11 inches wide Fragrance: sweet and fresh




Properties/uses: highly toxic, sedative and relaxant Conditions: moist soil with partial shade Size: 30-60 feet high, 1-2 feet wide Fragrance: floral-vanillic



JUNIPER





Properties/uses: autoimmune disorders, anti-arthritis

Conditions: full or partial sun, well-draining soil

Size: 3-32 feet high, 1-4 feet wide

Fragrance: intense with similarities to pine, cedar and gin



## **ARRACH/ORACHE**



Properties/uses: menstrual cramps, hysteria Conditions: well-maintained soil with partial sun

Size: 2 feet high, 1 foot wide Fragrance: little to no particular scent



Properties/uses: antioxidant, antibacterial, lowers blood sugar Conditions: indirect sunlight with coarse soil Size: 5 inches – 2 feet high, 1 foot wide

Fragrance: foul-smelling, can be similar to rotting onions/garlic



Properties: anti-inflammatory, antimicrobial, anti-oxidant, trouble sleeping, depression, epilepsy Conditions: full sun and well-drained oil Size: 11-23 inches high, 11 inches wide Fragrance: minty-lemon

### GINSENG



Properties/uses: improvement of overall health; tiredness, trembling, nervous disorder, hysteria, leprosy Conditions: moist, well-drained soil – planted in deep, dark soil Size: 12-24 inches high Fragrance: highly aromatic with a licorice-sweet flavor with earthy undertones



Properties/uses: muscle pain, arthritis, eczema, exhaustion and fatigue Conditions: grows well almost anywhere with damp, fertile ground; fast-growing, easily spreads Size: 4 feet Fragrance: faintly herbaceous with a bitter, slightly salty flavour




Properties/uses: cognitive (brain health) enhancement, anti-oxidant, antiinflammatory Conditions: warm environments but drought tolerable – well-draining, dry soil in a dry and sunny area Size: 14-30 inches high Fragrance: earthy, pungent with a "barnlike" scent (name means "smell of the horse")
